- 2. If you do not already have a Plussa card, you can apply for one: https://plussa.fi/liity
- 3. If you have not previously logged in to the Plussa.fi website, create a K-id using your Plussa card, it is easy to do.
- 4. Once you have logged in, you can sign up as a supporter by going to "My Details" on the left and then "Sponsored Items"
- 5. Select "Sign up as a supporter", enter the code SP10064 in the open field and sign up as a member. You will also receive a confirmation of your membership by email.

IT (Milla)

"I am Milla, a 4th year IT BBA student.

My own studies have included a few business courses, and a variety of courses in different programming languages and other software development. Many of the courses have included a project assignment, so you get to learn in practice.

There are many options in elective studies, I have mostly taken advanced courses to expand my own skillset.

The best courses have been those where I have been able to actually create and implement things myself and code with my classmates at in-person lessons, so project courses, for example, have been great."

Marketing (Roope)

"Marketing is very different from other orientations. The standard lectures are "training sessions" with your own "team coach" where you go through the basics of marketing, but at the same time you are already establishing your own joint marketing cooperative. Then you start looking for potential clients who could offer projects, for which they then pay the cooperative. The projects, clients, training leaders and price are determined by the members of the cooperative themselves. If you are interested in entrepreneurship, marketing may provide the best foundation. Other basic things are that marketing involves reading books, innovations, events, there are no exams and we have our own new premises! So see you in the "Office"!"



ORIENTATIONS

Business law (Tommi)

"Unfortunately, you can no longer choose this orientation, but it is good to introduce it anyway.

In business law, you can optionally focus your studies on accounting or law, personally I have chosen more law courses. My favorite course has been the family and inheritance law course, which covered, for example, making a will. Business law opens doors to the banking and finance sector."





Intelligent Financial management (Jasmina)

"Accounting, budgets, investing, running a company's finances... all of this (and much more) is financial management. With this orientation, you can get a job, for example, in an accounting firm, a bank, the stock market, or a company's finance department. I recommend this orientation to anyone who is interested in numbers and financial management!"

Commercialization (Ilona)

"Hi, I'm Ilona! I'm in my second year of studying commercialization. Commercialization is our newest orientation, which has replaced law studies. During the first year, we study our own courses and common courses with other BBA students, and only later do we fully dive into our own specialization. I'm only starting my second year of studies in the fall, so unfortunately I can't tell you much about commercialization studies yet. In this orientation you graduate as a project management professional and learn to understand the entire process under the commercialization chain - determining the profitability of a business idea, designing the idea into practice and exporting it to the market."

IB (Eleanor)

"Hii, I'm a second year student in International Business. We do almost all of our studies in English besides from couple courses, which makes it a great environment to develop your language skills. Since we have students from all around the world, the atmosphere in our classes is amazing, and you have a good opportunity to make connections internationally. The first 1,5 years are constructed of mandatory courses and after that you are free to choose from variety of complimentary courses depending on what you're interested in. In our school you also have an opportunity to do an exchange or even an internship abroad, so don't forget to apply if you're interested! Welcome to Lappeenranta:)"

The Spirit of Skinnarila

One of the most important things in Lappeenranta is the spirit of Skinnarila. This means that all people in Skinnarila live in harmony and never leave a friend behind! If you see that someone is feeling a bit under the weather, make sure they get home safely, especially in the winter when the weather is cold. Everyone in Skinnarila is welcome into events and evenings.

Typical hangout places

Skinnarila has a lot of different places where people usually hang out. These are good to know so that you can get involved and network with new people right from the start of your studies!

- G-bar is a great place to go after a Tuesday sauna night, for example.
- Punkkerikatu 5, where the above-mentioned Tuesday saunas are organised.
- Notskit is a popular hangout, especially during freshers' week and Wappu. It is a good idea to reserve barbecue food and cold drinks for the Notskis. You'll often see lots of older students there too, so it's worth a chat!
- Skinnarila Garden often hosts kyykkä games in the winter, so come and try out the traditional Karelian sport when the kyykkä experiment is organized!
- KOEs associations space (room 8163) is a hangout place open to everyone, where you can also meet a lot of student organization actives!

Lutikka A key to get around the school.

G-bar Cafe Bar G is a café/bar located behind the Student House/Kellari.

Gemmi Giggling Marlin (a nightclub in the city centre)

Noppa A study point.

Yolo Student Union Building.

SVV Skinnarila Free State.

Kyykkä A traditional sport, played with great enthusiasm.

Teekkari A generic term for a student studying a technical subject at university.

Kuutti A freshman business major from Enklaavi.

Kylteri Senior economist.

N-fuksi A senior student who started studying "N years ago".

Sitz An academic table party with a strong element of singing and refreshments.

Toasti akateemisen pöytäjuhlan vetäjä (toastmasteri) jonka sana on laki.

Läsy A songbook for sitsit or annual ball. Distributed to tables at the event.

Punamusta LTKY's songbook which is largely used at Sitzs and annual balls.

Vujut The annual ball of a student association, guild, club or student union.

Sillis Organised the day after the annual ball. Often there is food, mimosas and palju.

Tiistaisaunis/Tuesday saunanight Every Tuesday in turns, a sauna night is organized by the different associations and guilds in PK5.

KOE:n järkkätila/KOEs associations space A room (8163) near the LAB cafeteria, where all students are welcome.

Kellari A space on the bottom floor of the Student Union Building, where sitz and other parties are often held. There is also a sauna.

Excursio/Excursion A bus trip to see companies or other cities' student associations. Themes varv.
